



*ScD, Professor Malkhaz Zaalishvili* (1920-2016), distinguished Georgian Scientist, Member of Georgian National Academy of Science, was World-known biophysicist, Head of the Laboratory of Biophysics at I. Beritashvili Institute of Physiology (now Ivane Beritashvili Center of Experimental Biomedicine), the Director of the Institute of Molecular Biology and Biophysics Georgian Academy of Sciences, the Head of Department of Biophysics at Georgian Academy of Sciences and the Director of Central Scientific Library of Georgian Academy of Sciences. Professor Zaalishvili was the first, who established the Institute of Biophysics and Molecular Biology in Georgia. Professor Zaalishvili was the supervisor of many Georgian scientists and was actively involved in the development of Biophysics in Georgia. Professor Zaalishvili was awarded with the Order of Honor – one of the most prestigious governmental award.

Professor Zaalishvili was the author of 160 scientific articles, 11 inventions, and one monograph.

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
